Walnut Cinnamon Coffee Cake

Preheat oven to 350°

Grease a 9"x13" baking pan or a 10" Bundt cake pan

Ingredients:

1 cup packed brown sugar

1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon

1 cup chopped **walnuts or pecans**

1 yellow cake mix

1 package instant vanilla pudding mix (3.4 oz.)

1 package instant butterscotch* pudding mix (3.4 oz.)

4 eggs

1 cup water

1 cup vegetable oil

In a medium bowl, stir together the brown sugar, cinnamon and **walnuts or pecans**. In a another bowl (electric mixer is fine), stir together the cake mix, vanilla pudding mix, and the butterscotch* pudding mix. Add the eggs, oil and water, mix until well blended. Pour half of the batter into the pan, spread evenly. Sprinkle with half of the nut mixture. Cover with the rest of the batter, and sprinkle with the rest of the nut mixture. *Cover the top completely with the nut mixture as the cake rises quite a bit. This will keep it more even.*

Bake for 20 minutes in the preheated oven, then turn the oven down to 325 ° **and bake for an additional 35 to 40 minutes.**

* I have used 2 vanilla pudding mixes. I couldn't find butterscotch in an instant pudding and had read that it could be substituted. It was very good with the 2 vanillas. You might also want try another flavor sometime.
